## This funding will be used to

Improve English A-E data – a school average of 80% of students to achieve a “C” or above in English  
Improve NAPLAN reading and writing – 80% of year 3 and year 5 students achieving in the top 4 bands for reading and writing.  
Improve student engagement and attendance – over 85% of students maintaining >90% attendance

- Support differentiation and early years literacy development
- Support teacher engagement with the Australian Curriculum through pre-moderation of English and planning for differentiation and intervention
- Support case management of complex students
- Implementation of a school wide phonics and literacy intervention program
